3. RELEVANCE AND FOLLOW UP ACTIONS

40 participants attended the event. Within the participants were adult educators and trainers, stakeholders committee members, representatives from adult education institutions, adult education associations, VET providers, adult policy - makers, adult learners and other target groups interested in FLIP EDU UP project activities according to the Polish context’s specificities.

The event took place in Poland after the finalization of Intellectual output and the launch of learning platform. The event was engaging and involve testimonials from the adult educators as well as adult learners who participated in activities. Q&A and networking session took place at the end of the event to get familiar with project participants and look for exploitation of results and future cooperation opportunities.

The event was also web streamed as webinar. Google meet was used because offers “Real-time meetings by **Google**”. Using the browser, we could share our **video**, desktop, and presentations with teammates and target group [<https://meet.google.com/hem-kznr-tcx>].

After this multiplier event, the target group gained:

- A higher awareness about the outputs of the project and how they can use them;

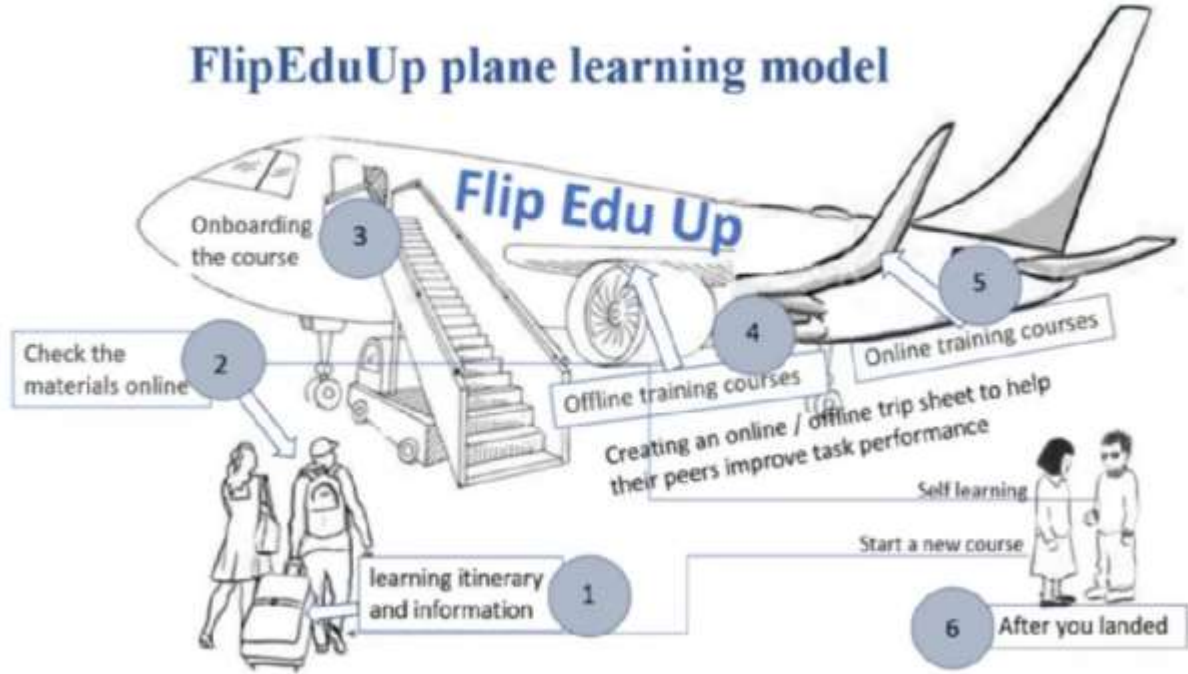


FLIP EDU UP

FlipEduUp plane learning model





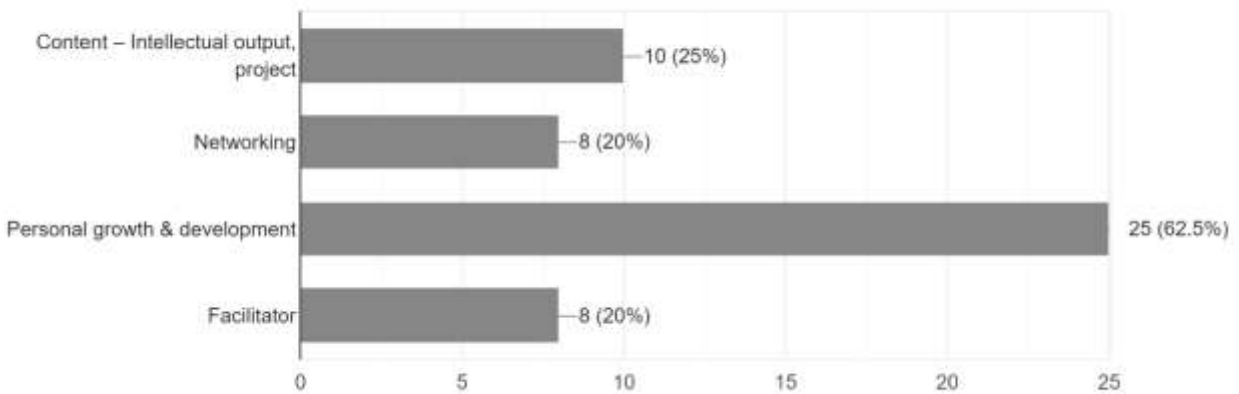




6. FEEDBACK FROM PARTICIPANTS

62% of participants declare that personal growth and development was the main motivation to participate in the event. This result makes us satisfied from the event implementation as the project objective is to:

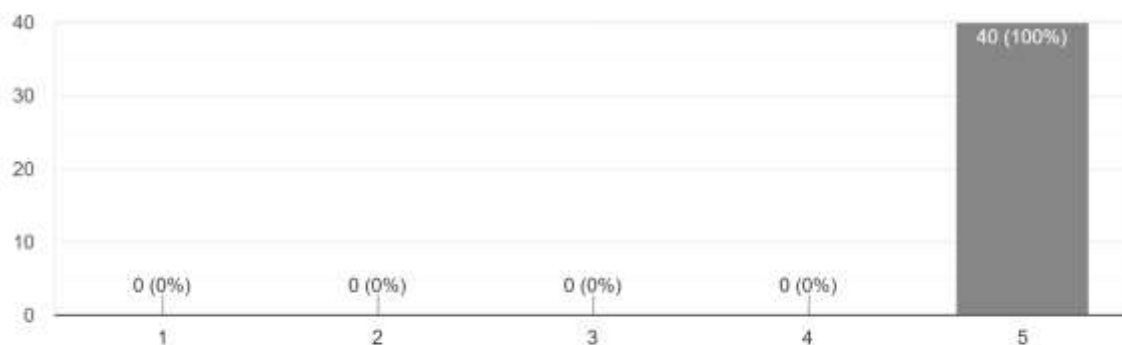
- Improve the teaching skills of adult educators/trainers

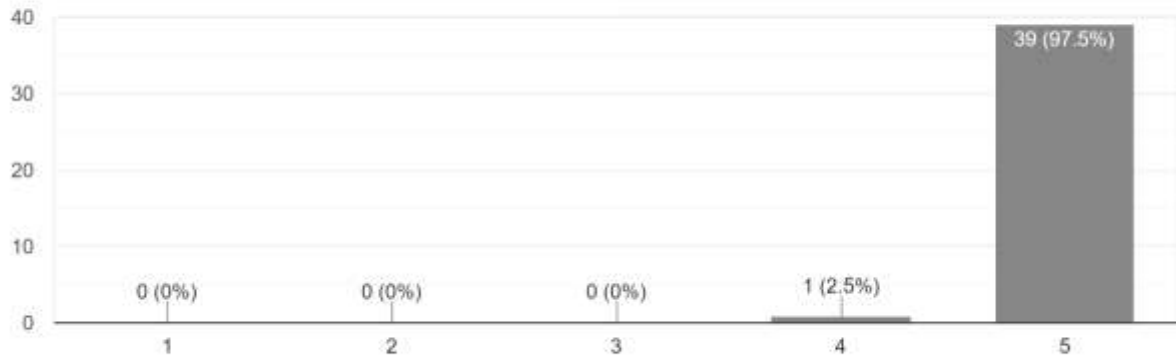
Success rate of the Multiplier Event

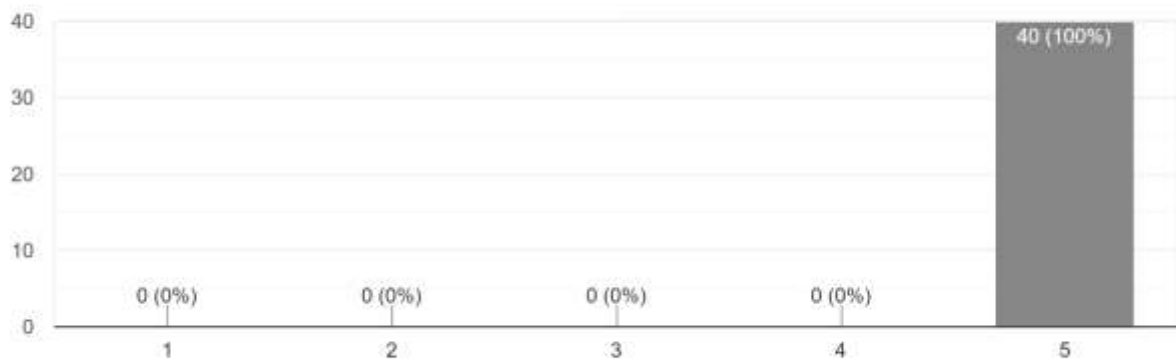
The content is relevant to my job

40 responses



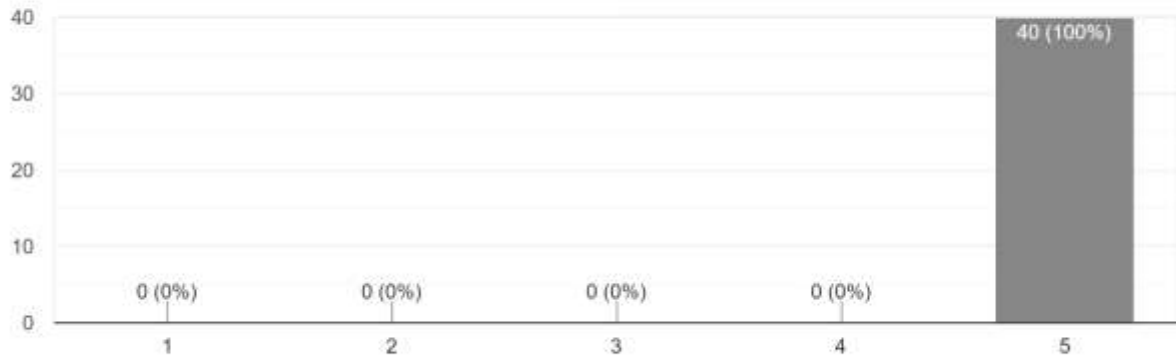
The event objectives were clear to me

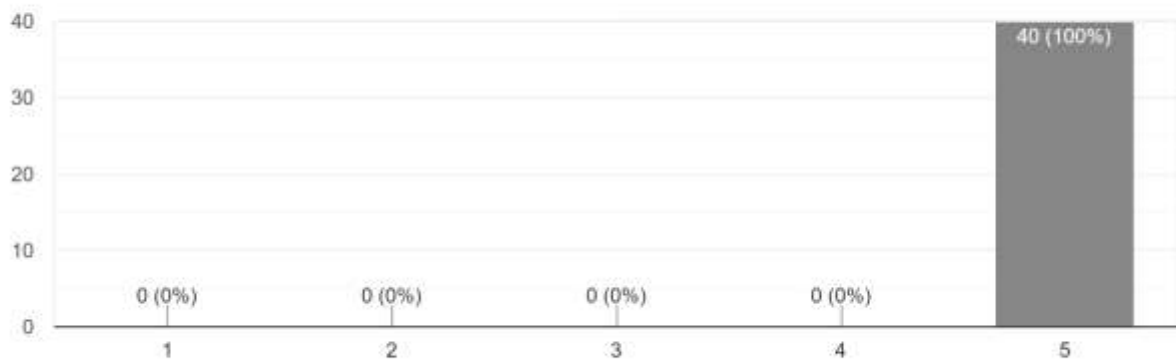
The activities in this event gave me sufficient practice and feedback

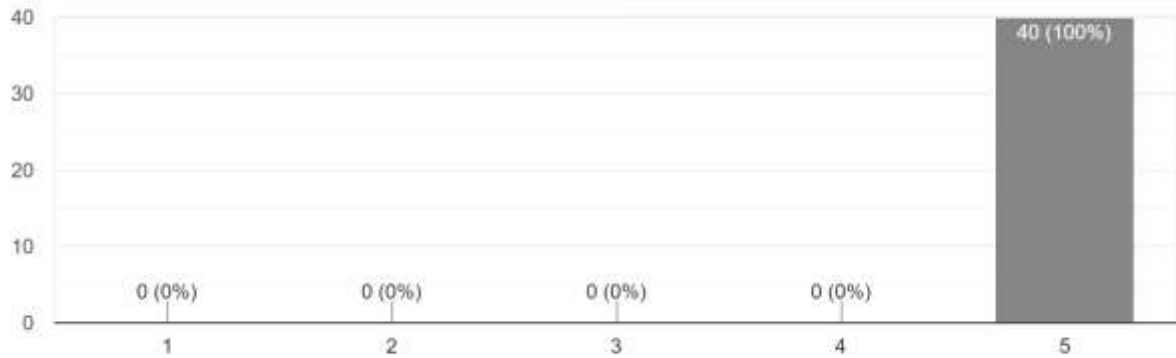
The facilitator was well-prepared

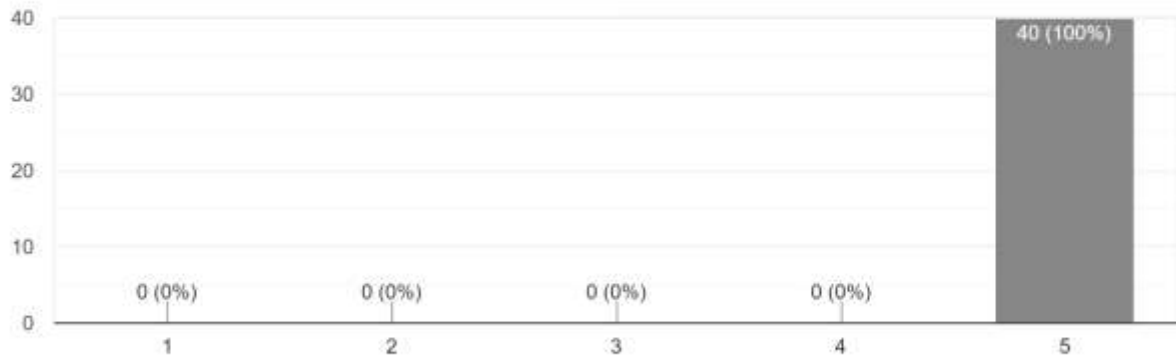
The intellectual output objectives were clear to me

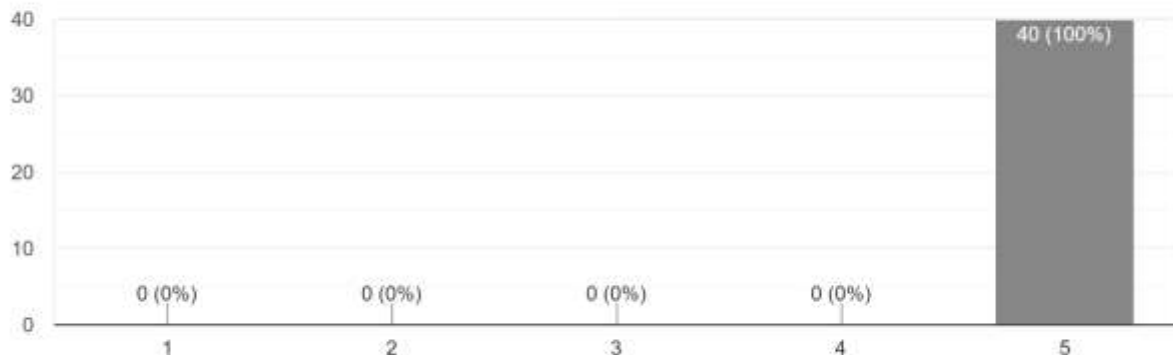
The activities in this event gave me sufficient practice and feedback to intellectual output
