

ASIDE results presented at the Erasmus+ project's virtual workshop in Spain

The ASIDE Virtual Workshop has been held in Spain the 29th of April with more than 20 attendees. This Virtual Workshop has presented the results of the Erasmus+ project ASIDE, on Adult Social Inclusion in a Digital Environment. Anna Tolosa, Project Manager of the Fundación Universitat Jaume I-Empresa (FUE-UJI), has presented this project on digital inclusion, the work done so far and the international consortium that has been implementing the project. The different reports developed within the framework of this Erasmus+ project have also been presented by Professor Javier Sánchez, part of the team working with FUE-UJI, partner of the ASIDE project.
